

# Christmas Bells

## Fir Tree - Angel

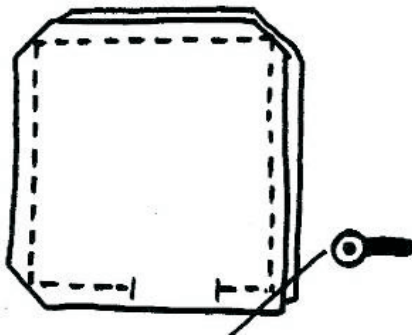
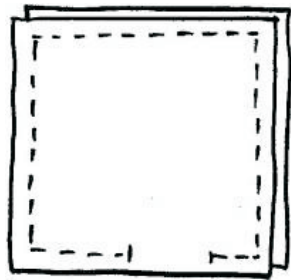

For one bell you will need:

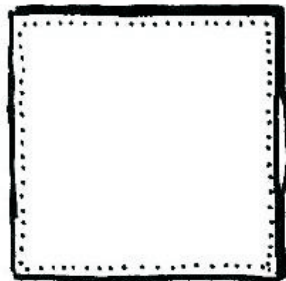
- 2 pieces of fabric 10 x 10 cm
- 1 big bead
- some bead yarn

### Instructions:

1. Place both fabric pieces right sides together. Sew all around leaving an opening for turning.



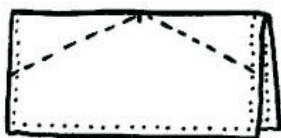
2. Cut the corners off the seam allowance carefully. Don't cut the seam!



3. Turn.

4. Sew all around using a contrasting thread.

5. Fold right sides together.

6. Sew 1.5 cm darts from the fold's center to the sides as shown in the diagram. Leave a 0.5 cm free space at the center. Secure Seams.

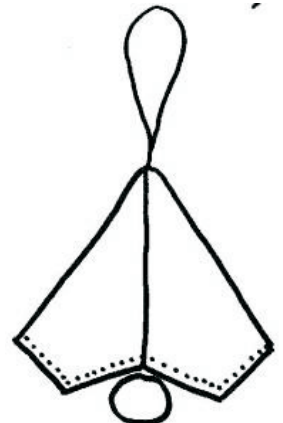
7. Now fold in the reverse direction; previous darts meeting in the center.



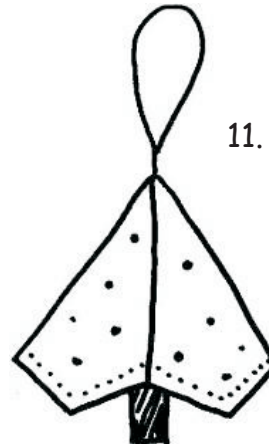
8. Sew two more darts as shown in the diagram.

9. Turn your bell.

10. Sew on the bead yarn by hand for a hanger loop on top and add the bead on the lower end.



11. For a fir tree use green fabric and add a stem made from a twig.



12. For an angel add a head from wadding and wings from foil.
