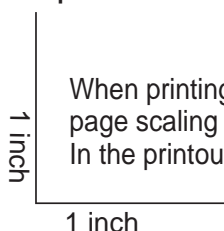

Paper Piecing Pattern

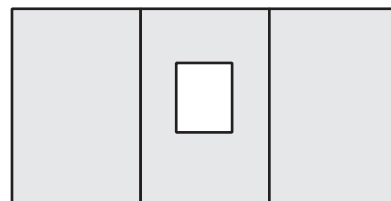


When printing the PDF file, please make sure that your page scaling options are set to 'none'.
In the printout, the lines below should measure exactly 1 inch.



Note: All project measurements are in centimeters.
Finished size: 6 x 8 and 5 x 6,5 cm plus seam allowances.

One-piece pattern for three-piece Passepartout cards.



Sew motifs in the order listed.

Leave plenty of fabric along the outer edge. Remove the paper, decorate and possibly line with thin batting. Glue behind the cut-out area of the card.

For reusable cards insert multiple sheets of paper in the center and secure them with a short stitch seam by machine. An original text can be found on the website under
Tips - sewing on paper - Reusable cards.

You can easily change the size of blocks to your needs by adjusting the page scaling in the printer settings of your computer or copier.

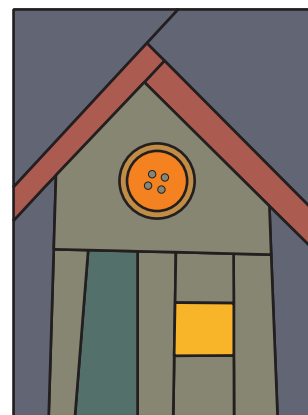
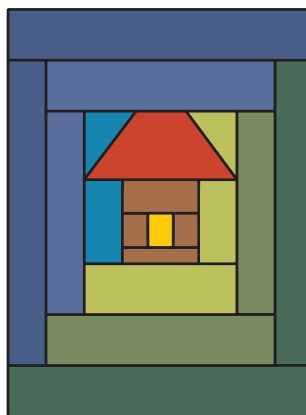
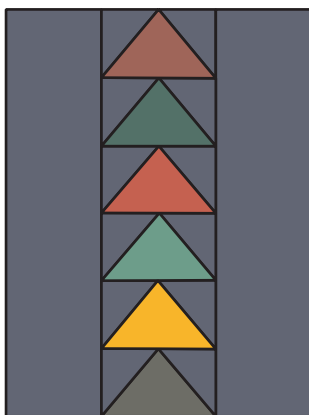
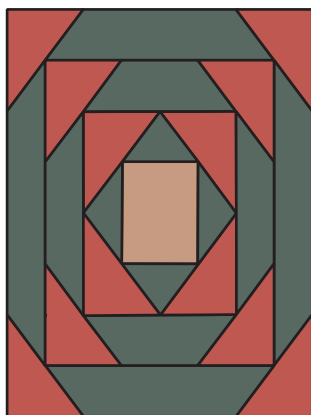
Here is the formula:

$(\text{Desired size}) / (\text{Actual size}) \times 100 = \text{percentage for scaling}$

Example: If you want to enlarge a block from its actual size of 6" to 8", you calculate: $8" / 6" \times 100 = 133,33 \%$.

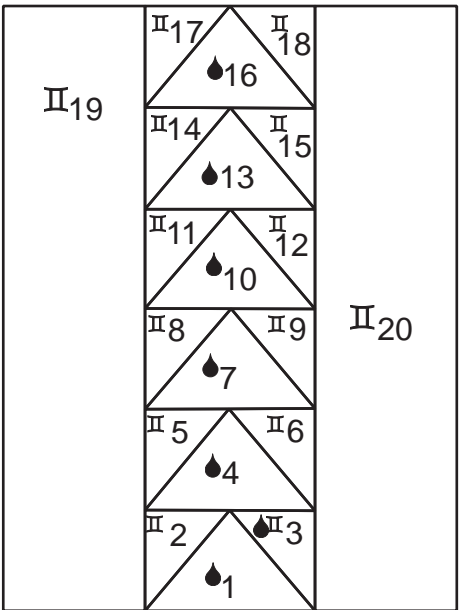
Fold to make a display



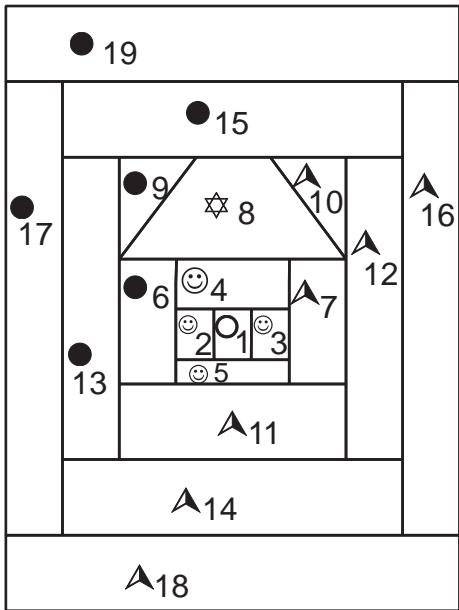

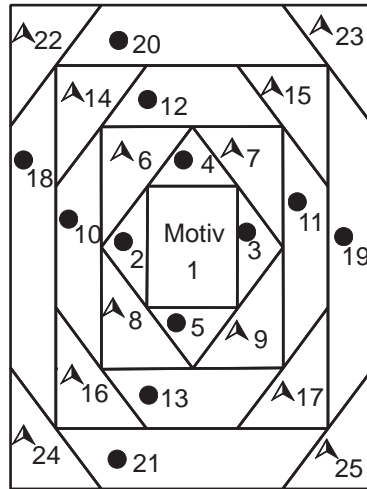


Foundations for Christmas cards 5 x 6,5 cm

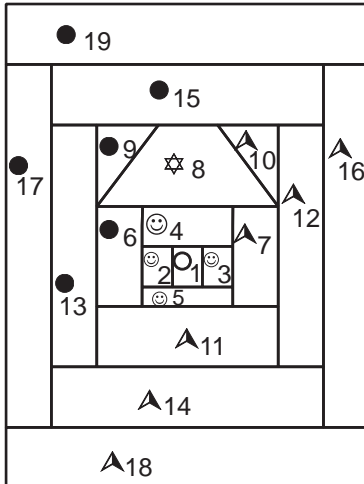
