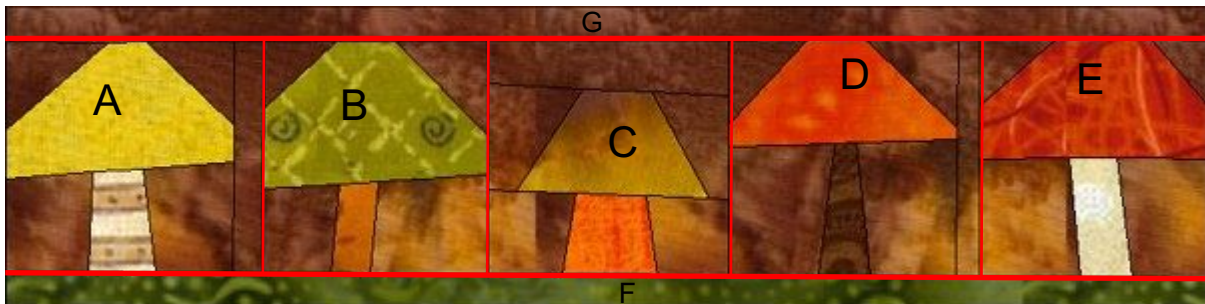

In the printout, the lines below should measure exactly 1 inch.

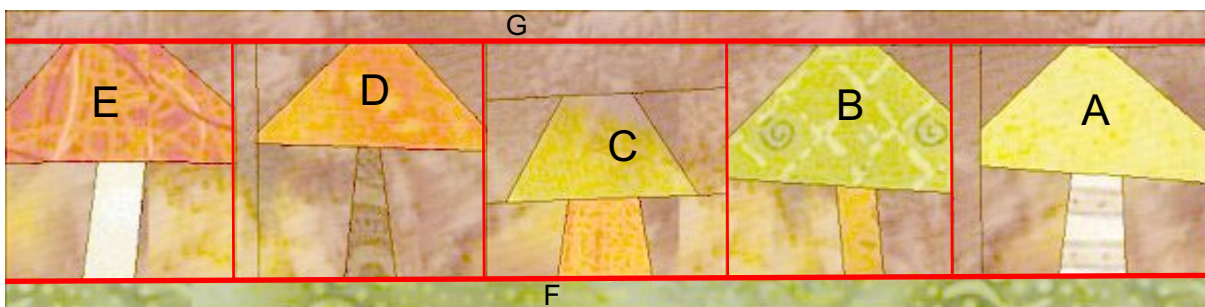

This is a block from a series. Download mushroomgarden.pdf from my website to see the entire layout plan.

All project measurements are in centimeters.

This block is offered in two sizes: 4x20 cm and 5x25 cm without seam allowances.

You can easily change the size of blocks to your needs by adjusting the page scaling in the printer settings of your computer or copier.

Here is the formula:

$(\text{Desired size}) / (\text{Actual size}) \times 100 = \text{percentage for scaling}$

Example: If you want to enlarge a block from its actual size of 6" to 8", you calculate:  $8" / 6" \times 100 = 133,33 \%$ .

This time you need to do some work on your own:

Transfer the numbers given for mushroom A to all the other mushrooms (or try sewing them in logical order without any numbers at all) and draw seam allowances around each block before cutting.

Use paper piecing to sew the individual segments A - E. Cut out template XX and use the already sewn mushrooms instead of fabric. Add G and F last.

Add borders as desired or collect all blocks for the Magic Mushroom Garden!

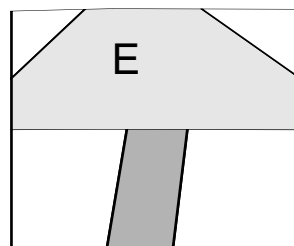
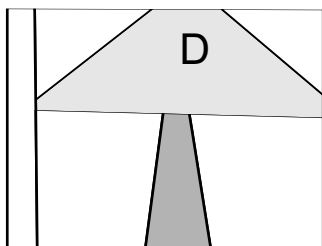
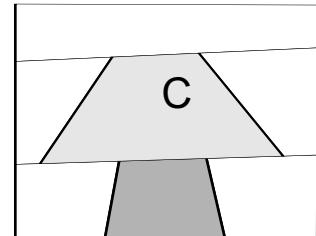
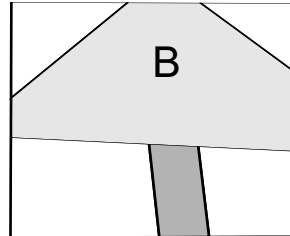
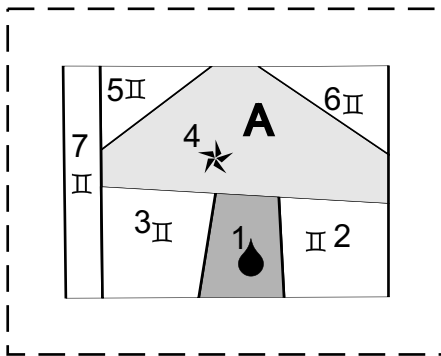

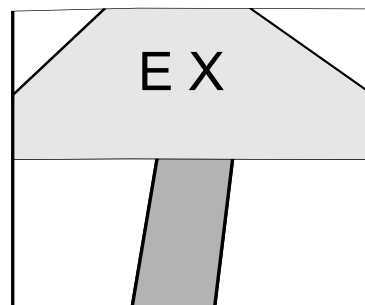
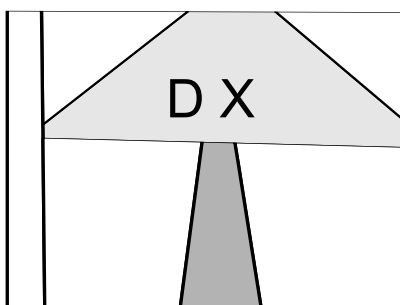
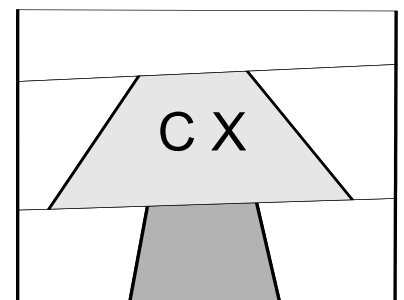
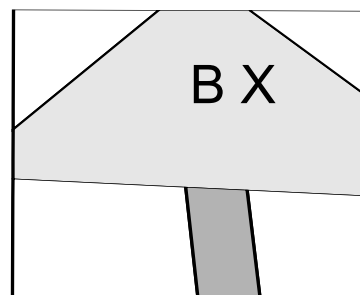
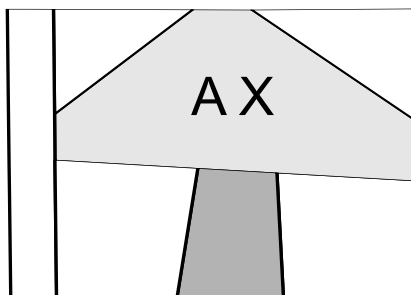


## Tips for PP Beginners

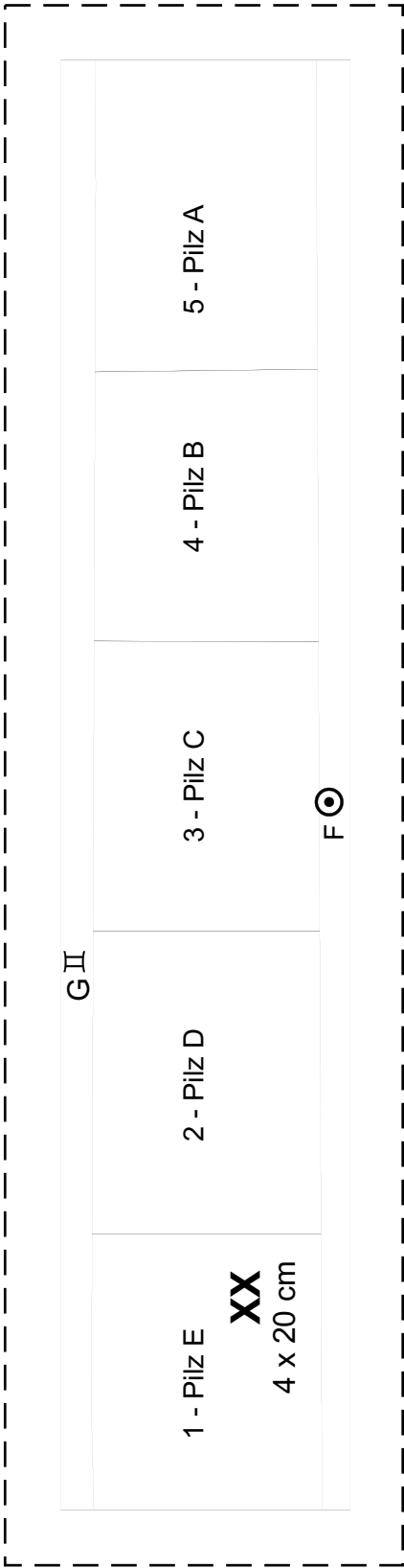
Use many different fabrics for stems and caps. Each mushroom consists of a single foundation. Just follow the numbers starting at #1. Pay attention to the symbols; they indicate the appropriate fabric for each piece.

Basic paper piecing principles are available in magazines, books, on the internet and in classes.
