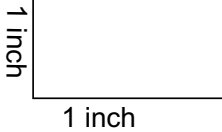

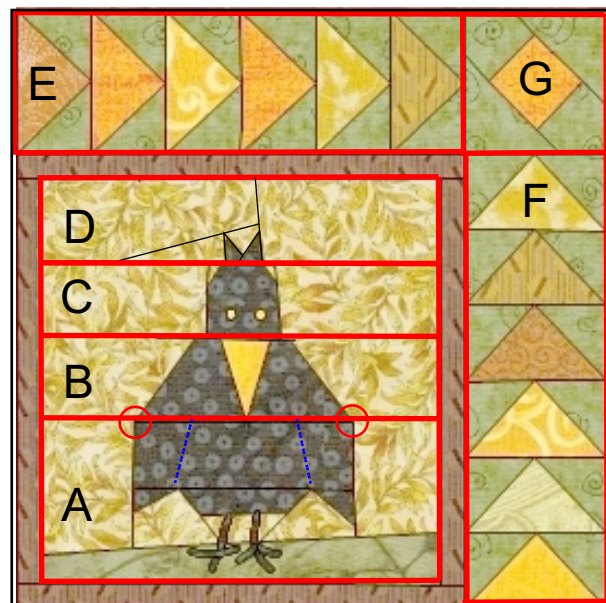
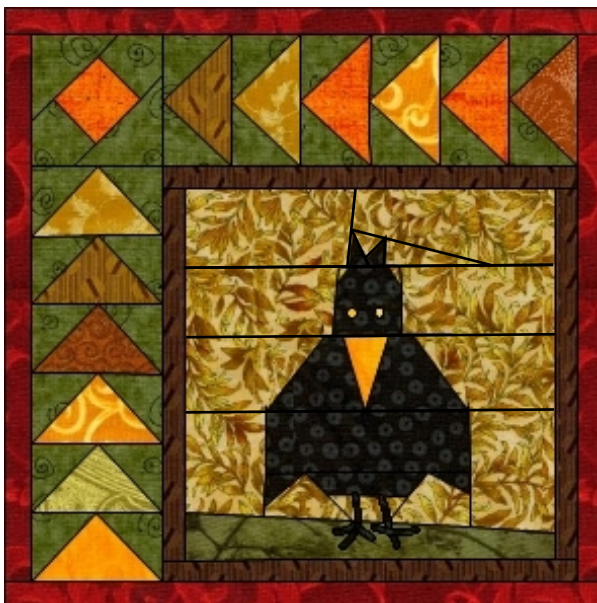

When printing the PDF file, please make sure that your page scaling options are set to 'none'.
In the printout, the lines below should measure exactly 1 inch.



All measurements are centimeters.



The finished block size is 17 x 17 cm including Flying Geese.

You can easily change the size of a block to your needs by adjusting the page scaling in the printer settings of your computer or copier.

Here is the formula:

$(\text{Desired size}) / (\text{Actual size}) \times 100 = \text{percentage for scaling}$

Example: If you want to enlarge a block from its actual size of 6" to 8", you calculate:

$$8" / 6" \times 100 = 133,33 \%$$

Use paper piecing to sew the individual segments A - D and join according to the diagram. Add a narrow border to the raven block and embroider eyes and feet. Sew and attach segments E, F, G. Add more borders if you like. Quilt in the ditch. Quilt the wings like shown in blue in the diagram. Add binding and hangers..
