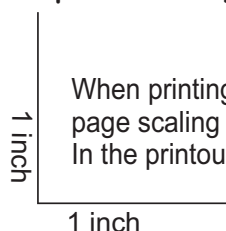


Tulips

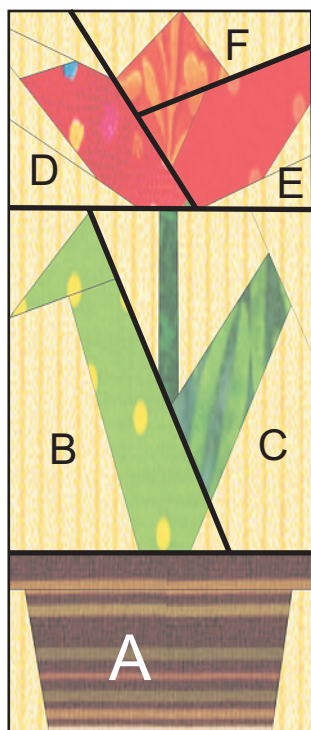
Paper Piecing Pattern



When printing the PDF file, please make sure that your page scaling options are set to ,none'.
In the printout, the lines below should measure exactly 1 inch.

Finished tulip block size is about 3 ½ x 8 ½ “.

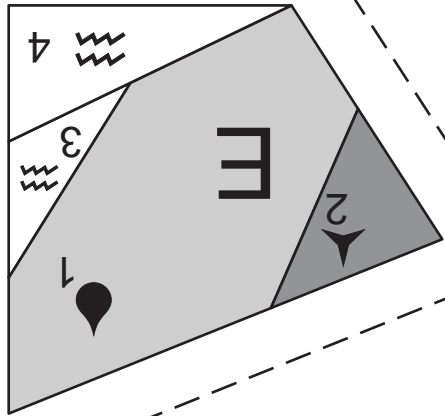
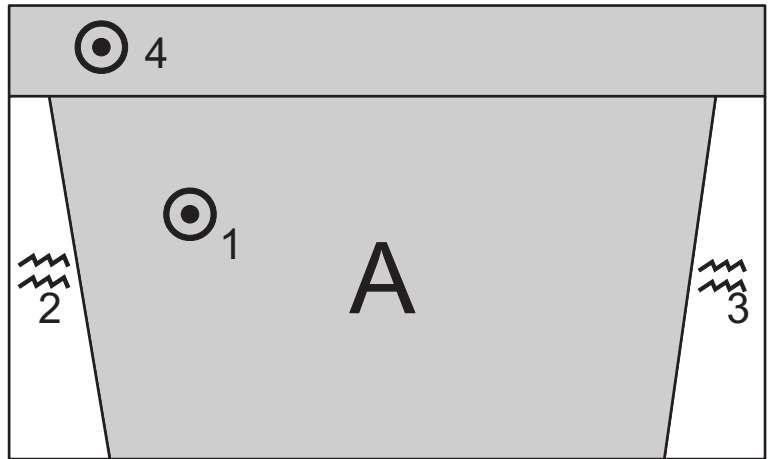
You can easily change the size of blocks to your needs by adjusting the page scaling in the printer settings of your computer or copier.
Here is the formula:
(Desired size) / (Actual size) x 100 = percentage for scaling
Example: If you want to enlarge a block from its actual size of 6” to 8”, you calculate: 8” / 6” x 100 = 133,33 %.

- Background
- Flower pot

- Petal 3

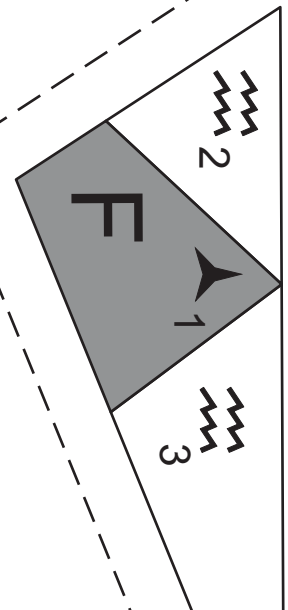
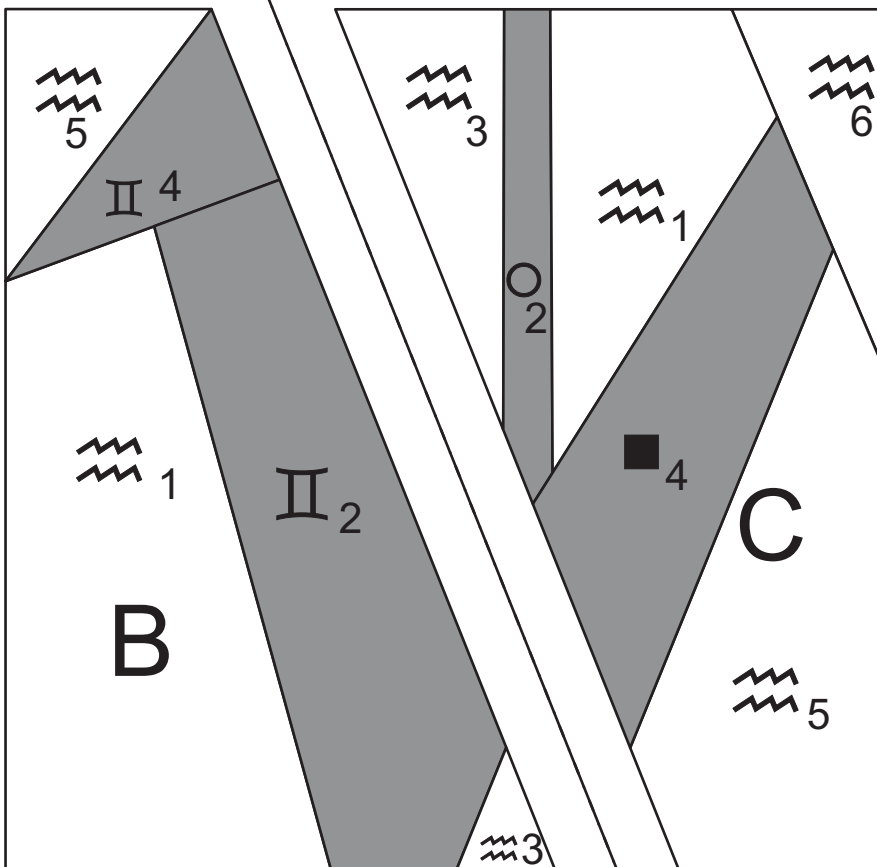
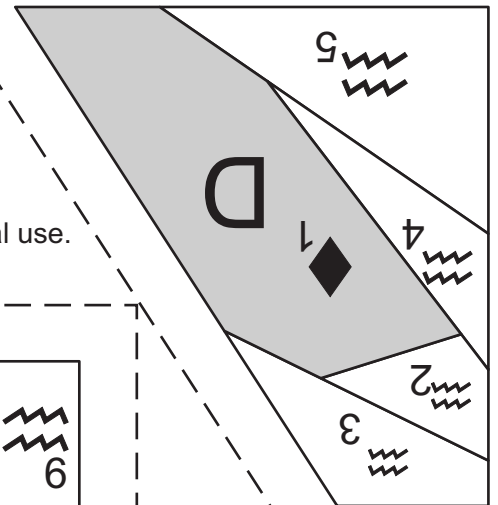
Use paper piecing to sew the individual segments and join according to the diagram. To make a wall hanging like mine add 1" stripes to the tulip block sides and a 2" strip above. A narrow followed by a 2" border complete the top.

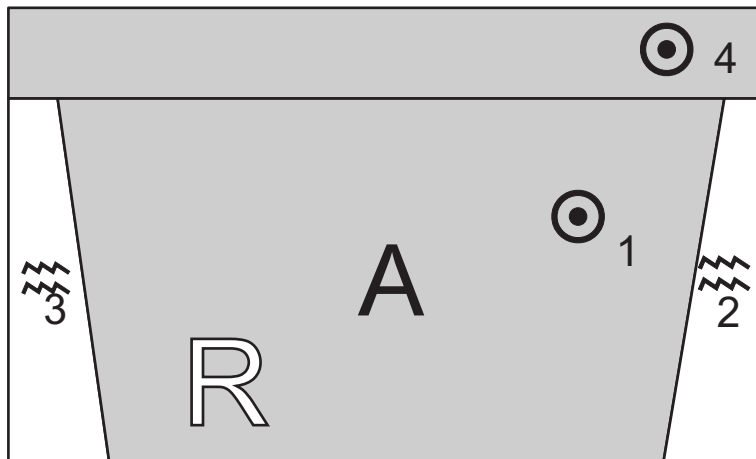
